I. Application Deadline

March 30, 2019 (For undergraduate)

April 30, 2019 (For graduate and PHD)

Remark: Please refer to the official notice of each university for exact deadline.

II. Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese national and be in good health.

2. Obtain no other Chinese Government Scholarship at the same time.

3. Education background and age limit:

(1) Applicants for Bachelor's Degree program must have high school degree and be under the age of 25.

(2) Applicants studying to earn a Master's degree must have a Bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35.

(3) Applicants studying to earn a Doctorate degree must have a Master's degree and be under the age of 40.

4. Requirements for language:

Students already studying in China are not accepted in principle.

III. Content and Criteria of Scholarship

- 1. Exempt from registration fee, tuition and fee for accommodation;
- 2. Monthly Living allowance:
 - (1) Bachelor's degree students: RMB2,500.
 - (2) Master's degree students: RMB 3,000.
 - (3) Doctorate degree students: RMB 3,500.
- 3. Comprehensive Medical Insurance for international students in China.

V. Application Material

1. 《CGS Application Form》 (Chinese or English).

2. Highest diploma (original copy and translated photocopy). The applicant must submit On-study Certificate issued by his/her university, if he/she is an on-campus student.

3. Transcripts (original copy and translated photocopy).

4. A study or research plan in Chinese or in English (no less than 500 words).

5. Academic recommendation. Two reference letters in Chinese or English from professors or associate professors.

6. Foreigner Physical Examination Form must be filled in English. The results are valid for six months.

7. Applicants who apply for Chinese-Medium Programs submit HSK transcripts (Those who need one-year Chinese remediation don't need to submit them).

8. Applicants who apply for English-Medium Programs submit transcripts of TOEFL IBT or IELTS (Students in Countries with English as the official language, common language or native language are exempt from the submission).

9. Applicants can submit certificates of academic achievements and all kinds of cultural and sports activities.
